

# Lamoille Valley Gleaning

Serving farmers and eaters in Vermont's Lamoille Valley. We engage and feed the community through collecting and distributing what farmers can't sell.

Gleaning is the act of reaping after the harvest.

## During 2018

- Collected 53 types of fruits and vegetables from 19 farms
- Distributed 210,501 servings of nutritious crops to 31 sites
- Engaged 215 individual volunteers including 19 different service groups, corporate teams, or youth programs





### People Power
